3. Report from Chairman:

- Annual report: Progress so far and plans for 2023 24: Jackie presented her annual report which will be posted on the website and to the Charity Commission.
 She highlighted:
 - ♦ The effects of the Covid 19 pandemic have lessened so we have got back to more usual levels of activity.
 - ♦ The replacement of damaged waymarkers and leaflet boxes.
 - ♦ The finalisation of the Right of Way on the old railway line in Top Field, Kings Worthy. The map of the route will be changed to reflect this.
 - ♦ Dawn to Dusk Day on 23 April 2023 was very successful and we ran 3 walks including a Dawn Chorus Walk.
 - ♦ The fencing at Wonston Bridge has been installed following a successful crowd funder and donations from Wonston Parish Council.
 - ♦ Installation of a magpost and bench at Worthy Down Halt plus 3 further benches in Itchen Abbas and Alresford.
 - Our successful collaboration with Watercress and Winterbourne to run a series of walks and to train volunteers.

- Accounts to year end April 2023: These have been agreed by the Trustees following auditing by David Mead.
