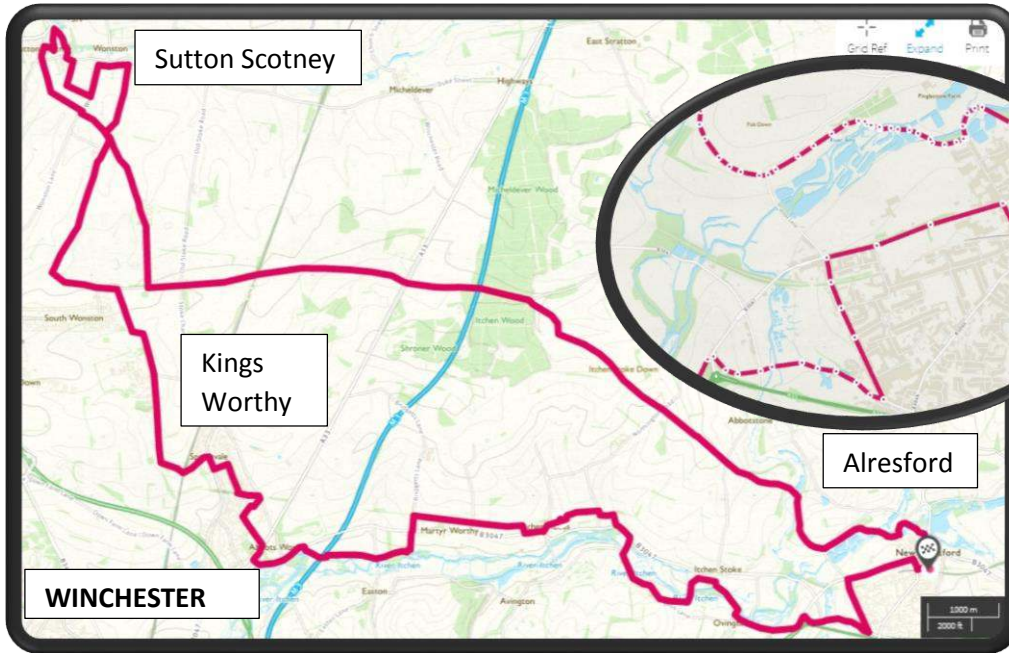


September 29th 2019 10.00-1.00



Walk part of the 26 mile Watercress Way



Starting at our main gateway to the trail: **The Watercress Line railway station SO24 9JG**

Search for 'ghosts of the past' in Georgian Alresford and along the Mid- Hants disused Watercress railway line & historic droves. See working watercress farms. Be a landscape detective!

Today's route is 4/5 miles: following parts of The Watercress Way and other routes: The Millennium, Arle Valley and Wayfarers trails. Optional shorter route
