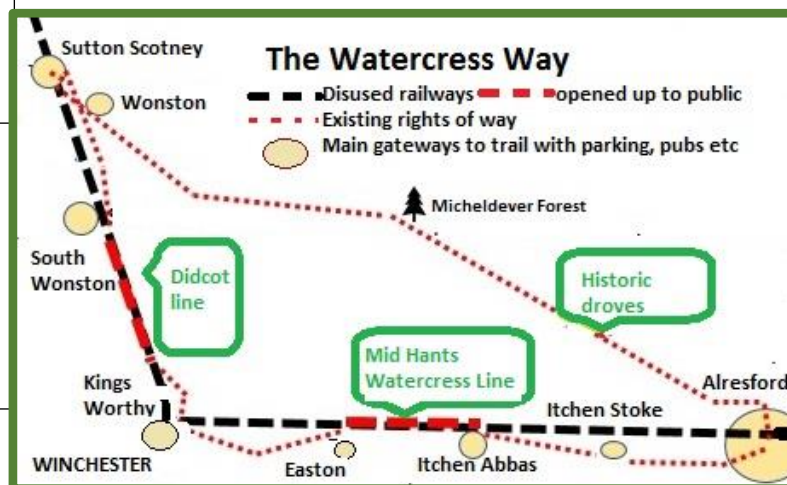
- North of village: **King Charles** pub, Lovedon Lane SO23 7NU 01962 881626 friendly, big menu, big garden + play area 0.5km from trail

- **The Swan**, only hotel on the trail .22 bedrooms. Old atmospheric coaching Inn, steeped in history. Relaxed ambience.
- **The Horse & Groom**, Broad St, SO24 9AQ, 01962 734809. 17th C warm, cosy inn
- **The Globe**, The Soke, end of Broad St SO24 9DB 01962 733118. Atmospheric, cosy, wonderful views over lake, garden
- **The Courtyard Tea Room**, tucked off Broad St, small courtyard for dogs outside, yummy snacks, historical photos in approach corridor
- **The Cricketers** pub, Jacklyn's Lane, SO24 9LW, 01962 732463 on SW part of trail near watercress beds, welcoming, good for kids, adventure playground, large carpark

Parking: at Station , **public toilets**, & Arlebury Park recreation ground (play area, zip wire) SO24 9JQ (free for 2 hrs)This recreation ground has great facilities for children, zip wire and access to River Arle with duck feeding with suitable food at Amy's feeding table, donations)

Train: The Watercress Line Station Rd SO24 9JG 01962 733810 with limited/seasonal heritage. train service to Alton and then mainline to London .Platform Café buffet.

Buses: No 67 along Itchen Valley or No 64 faster service straight to Winchester –Alton. C 41 to Basingstoke
